*The following is a list and brief description of the various types of volunteer opportunities that may be available to you.

Chapter Formation – Contact our office to see how you can start a Right to Life Chapter in your area.

Church Liaison – Volunteers would contact, recruit, and follow up with area churches to participate in annual fundraisers.

Computer/Data Entry – Detailed-minded volunteers needed to keep up with email records, databases, correspondence, etc.

Event Booths – The Western Region participates in several educational booths each year at area festivals. Volunteers help set up, distribute materials, and/or interact with visitors.

Event Support – Dedicated volunteers would be updated on upcoming high-exposure events (Marches/Walks, Lobby day, Prayer Vigil) in order to participate and show pro-life support.

Events: Coordinating/Fundraising - Creative and high energy volunteers would help with behind-the-scenes preparations for various fundraisers such as the Pro-Life Banquet, Carnation Sale, or Golf Tournament or assist with the implementation of the event itself.

Financial Support – Giving volunteers are encouraged to sign up for our Guardian Angel monthly newsletter and donate on a regular basis.

Media/Technology – Tech-Savvy volunteers can help with maintaining the website or providing IT support

Paperwork/Mailing – Organized volunteers would be great at helping with office paperwork and putting out monthly mailings.



Photographer – Artistic volunteers welcome to help memorialize our events on “film.” These photos would be featured on our web-site and as a way to chronicle our events throughout the year.

Prayer Partner – Perhaps the most important job on the list! Join spiritual forces in dedicated daily prayer for the unborn, mothers, fathers, and our lawmakers.

Recruiter – Highly social volunteers are meant for these outreach-focused tasks. Volunteers can focus on one (or more) of the following:

- Educate pro-choice proponents in the issue of life in the hopes of changing hearts and mindsets.
- Encourage pro-life advocates to become more actively involved in the cause in their community in general.
- Enlist active pro-lifers in our region to become members and/or volunteers for the MRL-WR.

Researcher – Scholarly volunteers would enjoy keeping up on the latest in the medical, political, social, spiritual world as it pertains to our cause, and passing on particularly pertinent information to be passed on to our members.
